



Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

## SCRIPTURE

Zechariah 13:1-4; 14:1-11

## SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, the prophet Zechariah's message spoke of a future day for God's people—a day they could look to in hope, a day when things would be better. Through Zechariah's message, we learned a few things that will happen “on that day”:

- The Lord will cleanse His people's impurity (Zech. 13:1-4).
- The Lord will fight for His people's victory (Zech. 14:1-7).
- The Lord will provide His people's security (Zech. 14:8-11).

## CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- When have you found yourself living for the wrong purpose and listening to the wrong people? How can we keep from doing this in the future?
- One day God will defeat every one of His people's enemies. How does this help us live with hope now? Why is it important for us to know God is the One who wins the battle, not us?
- Which is easier: allowing Jesus to sit on the throne of our hearts now or looking forward to the day when He will be the King over everything?

## FAMILY CHALLENGE

Choose an area of your house, yard, or community to do a clean up. Take before and after photos. After you've completed your project, look at the photos together. Talk about how these items couldn't move themselves and these areas couldn't clean themselves up—someone had to come in and make the area clean. This is what God does for us: we are powerless to cleanse ourselves from our sin, so God made a way for us to be made right with Him. Through Jesus's blood, God's people are cleansed from every sin.
